🌲 What is Firewise USA®?

Firewise is a national program by the **National Fire Protection Association (NFPA)** that helps neighborhoods reduce wildfire risk. It encourages homeowners to take simple steps to make their homes and community safer.

Bonus: Some Tahoe communities that joined have received **insurance discounts, renewed policies, and even rebates.**

- We need **at least 220 hours / year** (approximately 1 hour per home) to get certified.
 - ✅ Examples of Activities:
 - Clearing defensible space (0-100 ft from your home)
 - Fire-Safe Home improvements (vent screens, fire-resistant landscaping, etc)
 - Attending fire-safety workshops or inspections

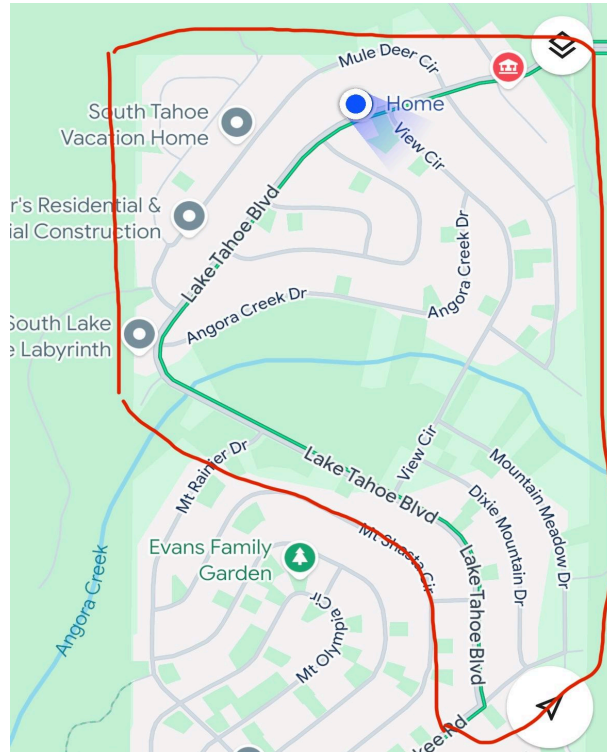
