

Neighborhood Banner Tutorial

These neighborhood banners are designed to allow each Fire Adapted Community to customize them in order to advertise workdays, community events, or specific information. An open space has been left in the middle of each banner for this purpose.

Step 1: Assess your banner and the information you want to share



Step 2: Purchase double-sided velcro strips from your local hardware store in order to attach a flyer or poster directly onto the banner. These can be found in assorted sizes but any velcro strips will work fine as long as they have one sticky, adhesive side for each piece.



Step 3: Attach several velcro pieces to your banner in the desired position. Make sure whatever side which goes onto the banner (the side that faces away from it) will correspond and attach to the pieces that you stick on the other material.



Step 4: Stick the accompanying velcro pieces to the material you wish to attach on the banner. You will want to make sure these line up. The velcro will not stick to printer paper well but rather a firmer material, such as a laminated flyer, a poster, or cardboard. It should be easily removable when finished.



You now have customized your banner to advertise events or information to your neighborhood!
